
If you are opening a business – or even doing some significant renovation/remodel work – there are some steps to be taken to ensure that your process moves along smoothly and incorporates the requirements of both the local building department and the fire district.

GENERAL / HIGH LEVEL FLOW

At a <u>VERY</u> high level, this includes:

- 1) Making contact with the local Building Department to make them aware of what you are doing (remodel, new tenancy, new construction...) always a good starting point
- 2) Required documentation, permits, and plans will then be determined, at which point the fire district (as well as other entities where appropriate) will be brought into the conversation
- 3) Upon approved plans, construction will then be allowed to commence
- 4) The specific "product" will then be reviewed/inspected for compliance
